YMCA Youth Sports programs have been on pause because of Covid-19.

**GOOD NEWS!** Texas Governor Abbott has announced that youth sports practices may resume May 31! **So YMCA Youth Sports practices and games will take place again beginning in June!** Although seasons will likely need to be modified, we are excited to get back to sports! Thank you for your patience.

Some may choose not to participate in the upcoming sports season and have inquired about refunds/credits. Please let the YMCA know if you would like to withdraw your child from this season of baseball, soccer, or volleyball by **May 27** so that we can reconfigure the teams.

With the extenuating circumstances and financial hardship caused by Covid-19, we must cover expenses already incurred and make the remaining balance available for refunds/credits.

#### Refund/Credit Amounts

**Baseball:** We have already paid for the charter, insurance, field lease, shirts and caps. If you would like a refund/credit please deduct \$65 from the amount you paid. That will be the amount you are eligible to receive for your refund/credit. You may come by the YMCA at the conclusion of the season to pick up your child's jersey and cap.

**Soccer and Volleyball:** If you would like a refund/credit, please deduct \$15 from the amount you paid. That will be the amount you are eligible to receive for your refund/credit.

**Girls Little Dribblers:** Practices were conducted; shirts were distributed. The season was well underway with 4-5 games completed. No refunds will be issued.
