



YMCA SAFE CAMP GENERAL INFORMATION

2024 Location – Central Elementary School, 800 Ennis, Plainview

We're excited that you have registered your child(ren) to spend part of their summer with us. Thank you!
Below is a list of helpful program information.

1. YMCA SAFE Camp is made possible through the collaborative efforts of the Plainview YMCA, City of Plainview, Hale County, and the Plainview Independent School District. **The program fee is \$70 per week, per child, and is to be paid by Monday or the first day of camp the child attends. The fee is \$70 regardless of how many days a week your child attends camp. (Week 1 fee is \$56; week 6 fee is \$56).** No camp on Thursday, July 4.
2. SAFE Camp will begin on Tuesday, May 28 and end Friday, July 12. The program starts at 8 am and ends at 5:00 pm. For safety reasons, school doors will be locked. You may drop off your child between 7:30-8:00 a.m. and pick up your child between 4:45-5:15 p.m. **If you need to drop off/pick up other than these times, please make arrangements by calling the Camp Director or the number posted on the entry door. If late in picking up your child, a fee of \$10/15 minutes will be charged.** Please use the Canyon Street entrance to drop off and pick up your child from the front entrance at Central Elementary. Exit on Ennis
3. Please sign your children in and out each day. **Anyone picking up a child from camp must be authorized and must be prepared to show their picture ID.**
4. Breakfast and lunch will be served daily on the weeks PISD offers the meal program. Generally, breakfast will be served between 7:45am – 8:30 am and lunch will be served between 11:00am – 12:30 pm. An afternoon snack will be available daily.
5. Weekly schedules will be available. They will include off-site activities and items your child may need to bring. We will post notes when we leave the site for field trips. We swim most Tuesdays and Thursdays. Your child will need a towel these days and may want to wear the swimming suit under clothes on these days.
6. We will have a lost and found box on site. If your child happens to misplace something try looking in the box. Please write your child's name on anything they bring to camp.
7. Field trips and activities are included in the \$70 weekly fee. If you would like to send additional money with your child for concessions, etc. during field trips, please put it in a sealed envelope labeled with your child's name.
8. Your children are welcome to bring a pillow and blanket to lie down on during quiet time each day. Please remember to write your child's name on his or her belongings.
9. YMCA core values are caring, honesty, respect, and responsibility.
10. We discourage bringing any technology devices to camp. We are not responsible for any lost or stolen items.

The YMCA SAFE Camp summer youth program will enforce a zero tolerance policy and follows Bus Safety Rules and Regulations.
