YMCA SAFE CAMP GENERAL INFORMATION

2022 Location – Ash School, 908 Ash Street, Plainview

We're excited that you have registered your child(ren) to spend part of their summer with us. It is going to be a fun activity filled summer. Below is a list of helpful program information.

1. YMCA SAFE Camp is made possible through the collaborative efforts of the Plainview YMCA, City of Plainview, Hale County, and the Plainview Independent School District. **The program fee is \$60 per week, per child, and is to be paid by Mondays or the first day of camp the child attends. The fee is \$60 regardless of how many days a week your child attends camp. **The fee will be pro-rated the first week of camp and the week of July 4th. (Week 1 fee: \$48; Week 6 fee: \$48) (No camp on Monday, July 4)**
2. SAFE Camp will begin on Tuesday, May 31 and end Friday, July 15. The program starts at 8 am and ends at 5:00 pm. You may drop off and pick up your children at any time during these hours. **DO NOT drop off your children before 7:45 am and children must be picked up before 5:15 pm. A late fee will be charged if deemed necessary.**
3. Please sign your children in and out. The sign in/out sheet is kept in a notebook that can be located on the desk by the camp entrance at Ash School.
4. Breakfast and lunch will be served daily on the weeks the PISD offers the meal program. Generally, breakfast will be served between 7:45am – 8:15am and lunch will be served between 11:00am – 12:00pm. On days the food program is not offered, campers should eat breakfast before arriving at camp and may be requested to bring a sack lunch.
5. Weekly schedules will be available by the sign in/out books. They will include off-site activities and anything your child may need to bring. We will post notes when we leave the site for field trips.
6. We will have a lost and found box on site. If your child happens to misplace something try looking in the box. Please write your child's name on anything they bring to camp.
7. Field trips and activities are included in the \$60 weekly fee. If you would like to send additional money with your child for snacks, etc. during field trips, please put it in a sealed envelope labeled with your child's name.
8. Your children are welcome to bring a pillow and blanket to lie down on during quiet time each day. Please remember to write your child's name on his or her belongings.

The YMCA SAFE Camp summer youth program will enforce a zero tolerance policy and follows PISD/First Student Bus Rules and Regulations.
